A Glimpse of the 1000 Year Reign Of Jesus Christ Part 2

In this second installment of the 1000 year reign of our Lord Jesus Christ, I will talk about the importance of the "Feast Days of the Lord" notice I did not say holidays. What is the definition of a holiday: Webster's dictionary defines holiday as a day of freedom from labor; day set aside for leisure or recreation. A day set aside by <code>law or man's custom</code> for the suspension of business usually in commemoration of some event. To take a vacation or vacation trip.

Now let's see what God, Himself, says about **His feast days or appointed**

times. God explains that the appointed times are to be "a perpetual statute throughout your generations in all your dwelling places" (Lev. 23:14). That means they are never obsolete or done away with, as some preach and teach. They are to be celebrated always. In Leviticus 23 God declares certain days on His biblical calendar. The biblical calendar is a lunar calendar. It is based on the phases of the moon. The waxing and waning of the moon determines the day of the biblical month. The tiny sliver of the new moon always appears on the



first day of the month; the full moon indicates the middle of the month; the disappearance of the moon indicates the end of the month.

In Leviticus 23 God declares certain days called "mo'adim", that is "appointed times" on the biblical calendar which is the calendar we will use during the 1000 year reign." God declared specified times as mo'adim "appointed times" which means the times God personally wants to meet with us, "His people!" The big mistake we as Christians make is to say "oh those are just for the Jewish people." It is true that God gave His appointed times to the people of Israel. He told Moses to tell the Israelites, The Lord's appointed times which you shall proclaim as holy convocations-----My appointed times are these (Lev. 23:2). The Jewish people were the people who kept and followed God's calendar as well as all the people who were joined to them as written in Lev. 24:22 "You are to have the same law for the foreigner and the native-born. I am the Lord your God." Again in Exodus 12:49, as well as in Num. 15:16, 29 God does not refer to them as Jewish festivals. He refers to them as "My appointed times." They are God's holy days. Paul asks, "is God the God of the Jews only? Is he not the God of Gentiles also" (Ref. Romans 3:29). The Bible never offered Gentile Christians any alternative festival days.

This next statement may shock some who read this newsletter and are not aware of the truth of God's Word. During the 1000 year reign, we will not celebrate Easter (which comes from the pagan fertility goddess Ishtar, and all the vestiges which come with it). I have written a newsletter regarding this pagan holiday, and I will not rehash this holiday. The other holiday which will not be celebrated is Christmas because it is not the BIRTH DAY OF JESUS CHRIST. JESUS WAS BORN DURING THE FEAST OF TABERNACLES, which I proved by the Scriptures, in a letter I wrote to all the partners of this ministry and several Pastor friends of mine. The Feast of Tabernacles which during 2015 it falls in the month of September on the Gregorian calendar and on God's it always begins on the 15th of 7th month now know as Tishrei on the Hebrew calendar. Also on this day a **Super Blood Moon** will appear which has significant meaning. And if you know the Word of God written in John 8:32 Jesus proclaims "you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." The question you must ask yourself is, "Am I in bondage, because I prefer to celebrate men's holidays instead of God's" appointed times?"

In the Millennial Reign we will celebrate Passover, Pentecost, and Feast of Tabernacles. Another thing to remember is that these "appointed times" of God are dress rehearsals for us right now, to participate in to be ready for His Kingdom

reign, the 1000 year reign! Again I want to emphasize that there will be **no pagan oriented holidays**, or any empty deceit or philosophies of men and the world to promote their agenda allowed! Instead we will all be focused on God's agenda. (Ref. **Colossians 2:8**)

Now I would like to talk about <u>Passover</u>, <u>Pentecost</u>, and the <u>Feast of Tabernacles</u>. These three feasts occurred during three different seasons: spring, summer, and fall. Of the seven feasts (God's appointed times), <u>all males over age twenty we required to attend</u> these three each year in Jerusalem. (Ref. Exodus 23:14-17)

I would like to talk about the spiritual application which is concealed in all of these feast's. Passover which started in Egypt represents the season of your redemptive covenant by the blood of the "Lamb of God." In Egypt they killed a Passover lamb without spot or blemish and put its blood above the doorposts and lentil. Pentecost is the season representing your baptism in the Holy Spirit, which I pray anyone who reads this letter and has not received this free gift (Ref. Luke 11:13) earnestly seeks to receive this gift. Since we are living during the end of the age of grace (many know it as the last days) this gift will strengthen you and help you pray the perfect prayer when you don't know what to pray. (Ref Romans 8:26)

The feast of Tabernacles can be an imagery of the resurrection of your mortal body and your entrance into the Millennial kingdom of Jesus the Messiah. I also want to talk about what Almighty God says about the feast of Tabernacles, remember this is the TRUE "BIRTHDAY of HIS SON JESUS" and it is also a rehearsal for the "Coronation of the KING!" God says this in Zechariah 14:16-17 And it shall come to pass that everyone who is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem **shall go up from year to year to** worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the Feast of Tabernacles. ¹⁷And it shall be that whichever of the families of the earth do not come up to

If you are hearing that voice in your mind saying you know that God didn't really mean that everyone will celebrate that Jewish holiday? Well I suggest that you might be listening to that same voice who spoke to Eve thru a serpent. Selah (think about it).

Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD

of hosts, on them there will be no rain.

We all know God means what He says and says what He means! It is time the church opens her eyes to a Kingdom mentality it is not about us, it is about what God wants. Now the question you must ask yourself is - Are you going to follow your own agenda, or be obedient to God, and meet with Him at His "Appointed Times".
