Jesus could have started His public ministry with a healing service or a deliverance session. Instead, He performed a miracle, turning water into wine so that a bride and groom could avoid embarrassment, so that a party could continue.

Didn't Jesus have more important things to attend to? What was He thinking? What about all the hungry people who needed feeding, the blind who needed to see? What about restoring worship in the temple, freeing the demon-possessed, silencing gale-force winds, and walking on water?

Jesus knew the time would come for Him to comfort the ugliness in people's hearts. He knew about the suffering that lay ahead and the resistance He would face. But right now it was time for a party. True, the bridegroom hadn't been quite ready for the wedding, running out of wine before the celebration was half finished. Jesus wasn't quite ready either.

But three years later as He hung on a Roman

cross dying for our sins, it was completely different story, because now the Bridegroom was ready. That day Jesus declared His work "finished," for the purpose of His life and ministry was to prepare His people to become His spotless bride.

At Cana He had changed water to expensive wine. On the night before He died, He lifted a cup of wine, saying to His friends: "This cup is the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you." Luke 22:20 NKJV. On the cross He turned the costly wine into His own precious blood.

After Jesus' resurrection, the Spirit of God moved on His disciples so powerfully that three thousand people became believers in one day. **Jesus**, through the power of the Holy Spirit at work in His followers, was drawing people to Himself, changing the course of history, giving us the best news we could ever hear, throwing the greatest party anyone had ever attended. The prophecy's symbolism involves a prince called Gog of Magog, leader of Rosh, Meshech and Tubal, who leads a coalition that includes Persia (Iran), Cush, Phut, Gomer, and Beit Togarmah against Israel. According to Ezekiel 39; When Magog and her allies attack Israel, God will intervene and decimate the armies of Magog and its allies. Because of this, it is written the Jewish people will give glory to God. The winning of this war will cause the Temple to be rebuilt as a part of the signing of the "Seven year" peace treaty.

One of the reasons the Rabbinical Counsel believes that the third redemption is at hand is: When the days of Israel's iniquity have been fulfilled, then the last redemption, the Messiah will come to save Israel from the anti-christ and set up His kingdom on earth. According to **Ezekiel chapter 4** Ezekiel was to lay on his side for 390 days for Israel's (rebellion) iniquity but only 40 days for Judea. **Leviticus 26** we discover that Israel will be punished 7 times for their iniquities (sins).

The house of Israel began the counting of this time of Israel's iniquity in 722 B.C., when Israel's captivity to the Syrians began. The 390 days (using the day = year rule) x 7 = 2730 years. 722 B.C. + 2730 years = 2008 since there is no zero year it makes the final year of Israel's iniquity being fulfilled in 2009.
