We Are The Terminal Generation

(Continued from our last newsletter issue)

As we mentioned in our last newsletter there are seven prophetic signs that prove we are the terminal generation and will see the coming of Jesus Christ. In the last issue I listed four. I will finish with the last three in this newsletter.

The fifth prophetic sign that we are the terminal generation is given by Jesus to his disciples on the Mount of Olives who warned: "Take heed that no one deceives you" (Matthew 24:4). Deception is going to be a cardinal indicator of the terminal generation, and although deception has always been with us, the coming Antichrist and False Prophet will take deception to a new level.

The Antichrist will come as a man of peace, but he will bring global war covering the world in blood.

Secular humanism will teach that there is no absolute right or absolute wrong. I wonder what part of "Thou shall not" in the Ten Commandments they don't understand. Secular humanism is deception, for it holds that man can assume or take the role of God.

Neopagan environmentalism will present Mother Earth as a healing force in the world. There is no "Mother Earth." If you are a Christian and a follower of Jesus Christ there is only Father God. Now if you believe nature can heal you, the next time you get sick, go out and hug a mulberry bush and watch the results!

The Bible and its eternal truths will be mocked, and those who believe them will be ridiculed and mocked. Bible prophecy declares that deception will be epidemic on the earth in the terminal

generation: Everyone will deceive his neighbor, and will not speak the truth; they have taught their tongue to speak lies; Weary themselves to commit iniquity. Jeremiah 9:5 NKJV

But the world will be ready for him, eager and willing to believe anything he says or desires. Why wouldn't it be? For generations, we've been cutting our teeth and weakening our wills with lies from national leaders.

Satanism and teachings of the occult are nothing but deception. We must remember Satan can't duplicate the works of Jesus so Satan must imitate His works. The apostate church, which has a form of godliness but denies the power of God, is peddling sheer deception because it has exchanged the truth of God for a lie (see 2nd Timothy 3:5). Such churches deliberately ignore the imminent coming of Christ, saying, "Where is the promise of His coming? For since the fathers fell asleep (died), all things continue as they were from the beginning of creation" (2nd Peter 3:4). The truth of God's Word is the immunization against deception.

The sixth prophetic sign: Famines, Pestilences, and Earthquakes.

In Matthew 24, we see more proof that we are the terminal generation as it states, (v7) "And there will be famines, pestilences and earthquakes in various places."

America has the ability to feed the world, yet we pay farmers not to grow certain crops lest they flood the market and drive prices down. And on television almost every night we see footage of starving children with bloated bellies, bulging eyes, and bare

ribs. There are many hungry children even here in the United States.

The (NIV) translation calls these things "the beginning of birth pains." Famine, pestilences, and earthquakes are the pains experienced at the birth of the terminal generation. When a woman begins to feel her first sharp pains, she knows the end of her pregnancy is near. The event she has been waiting for is finally upon her.

The Jewish people know about these birth pains. Hebrew eschatology, called acharit ha-yamim, describes the pre-Messianic era as one of great upheavals and wars, known as "the birth pangs [pains] of the Messiah," and Jewish suffering and exile.

The Talmud describes this era as the "footprints of the Messiah" a time when arrogance will increase. The government will turn to heresy, and there will be no one to rebuke its wrongdoing. Young people will shame their elders; a person's own family will become his enemies.

Pestilence— Incurable disease— is another sign that we have reached the terminal generation. According to Joshua Lederberg, a Nobel laureate from Rockefeller University, many experts were confident in the 1960s that medical science had solved forever the problem of infectious diseases. But today, say the medical experts, disease is on the march, and the human race is not ready to defend itself against what is really "an unending siege by pestilence."

A few years ago we discovered AIDS, the Ebola virus, and antibiotic-resistant bacteria. None of these will be conquered easily. AIDS alone is a medical black hole that has touched the life of practically every American, and after more than a decade of intense research, many who get it will die.

According to the most recent mortality study by the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, AIDS is now the leading cause of death for twenty-five to forty-four-year-olds and was ranked as the eighth leading cause of death overall for Americans in 1992. Scientists

estimate that 1 million Americans—1 in every 250 people—are infected with HIV.

In the Bible it is recorded that God repeatedly used earthquakes to achieve His divine purposes. Revelation 16:18, 20 ... (v18) and there were noises and thunderings and lightenings, and there was a great earthquake as had not occurred since men were on earth. (v20) Then every island fled away, and the mountains were not found.

God used earthquakes at the crucifixion to split the veil from the top to the bottom. It was God's way of saying you no longer need another human being to intercede for you in prayer; you as an individual can walk directly into the presence of God in the Holiest of Holies.

God used an earthquake at the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Not to let Him out, but to let us in. The empty tomb in Jerusalem is the only tourist attraction on Earth where people line up to see absolutely nothing. Think about that!

God used an earthquake to set Paul and Silas free from the jail in Philippi. God will use an earthquake to announce the coming of His son when the islands of the sea disappear and the Mount of Olives splits in half.

The seventh prophetic sign: The seventh prophetic sign that we are the terminal generation is the statement from Jesus to His disciples: "But as the days of Noah were, so also will be the coming of the Son of Man be." "For as in the days of before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the Ark," "and did not know until the flood came and took them all away, so also will be the coming of the Son of Man be." Matthew 24:37-39 NKJV.

It is true that "no man knows the day or the hour" that Jesus is returning to the earth. This is a statement of a twentyfour-hour period. Jesus' illustration of Noah is an entirely different prophetic matter. Here's why!

God told Noah that a great calamity was coming on the earth and his mission was to build an Ark for the salvation of all who would get on board. It took Noah over 100 years to build the Ark. After the Ark was built, God helped him gather the animals two-by-two placing them on the Ark. Then, Noah and his family of eight were the only ones who believed the message of coming doom. They got on the Ark and God shut the door.

When you are Noah on the Ark with your family and the animals with God having just shut the door, you know the only thing left is the flood. The next thing you are listening for is rain. It came and the fountains of the deep were opened and the world and all that were in it drowned in the flood.

Prophetically, we are exactly in the position of Noah on the Ark, hence the words of Jesus, "As it was in the days of Noah." The message has been preached; those who believe are getting on board with Jesus Christ. We are patiently waiting for the sound of the trumpet and the rapture of the church.

The Bible says, "Now when these things begin to happen, look up and lift up your heads, because your redemption draws near." Luke 21:28 NKJV

We can all look up and rejoice. All of these prophetic signs have been fulfilled. Rejoice, the King is coming! We are the terminal generation.
