Scripture of the Quarter

V16 "For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God.

And the dead in Christ will rise first."

V17 "Then we who are alive and remain will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord."

1st Thessalonians 4:16-17 NKJV

The Lord put a burden on my heart to write an article about the Rapture, due to the Lord's soon return for His bride. If you watch the news and read the newspaper you have to believe the coming of the Lord is soon. I want you to know if you have heard that all people that call themselves a Christian will go in the Rapture, they won't. Let me explain, when you read these parables that Jesus Christ told, you will understand. Read Matthew 24:36-42 and Matthew 25:1-12. A lot of people don't realize both of the aforementioned scriptures are related to the Rapture. Let me summarize Matthew 24:40 this verse states that two men will be in the field and one will be taken and the other left. It is important to do word studies to understand the context of the scriptures we read and if you don't you will miss a lot. The New Testament is written in Greek. In Greek the word taken is paralambano which means to receive near, associate with oneself (in any familiar or intimate relationship). If you read John 14:3 when Jesus says, I will come and receive you to Myself it would be the Greek word paralambano. Now let's look at verse 41 this verse states that two women will be grinding at the mill: one will be taken and one will be left.

Now let's look at **Matthew 25:1-12** where it talks about the virgins. Again I will summarize this chapter. I encourage you to read all the scriptures I'm giving you. If you have any questions you can call me at the number listed on the newsletter. Now here we have ten virgins (all virgins) as we refer to ourselves as all being Christians. Notice it says five were wise and five were foolish. As you read further it tells you the bridegroom (**Jesus**) was delayed and the <u>five wise virgins</u> had extra oil for their lamps but the <u>five foolish virgins</u> ran out of oil. The five foolish virgins pleaded with the five

wise to give them some extra oil. The five wise virgins advised them to go to a vendor and purchase more oil. When the foolish virgins left to buy more oil the bridgeroom (Jesus) returned. V10-12 "And while they went to buy, the bridgeroom (Jesus) came, and those who were ready went in with Him to the wedding; and the door was shut." V11 "Afterward the other virgins came also, saying "Lord, Lord, open to us!" V12 But He answered and said, "Assuredly, I say to you, I do not know you."

Can you imagine the **Lord** telling you He did not know you? What is the Rapture? It is a one time event for faithful overcomers. I would like to clarify something: heaven is a reward for salvation, when you have truly accepted Christ as your personal savior as stated in **Romans 10:9-10**. After accepting Christ your walk begins with Jesus. You let Him into your heart and the transformation begins as it states in **2nd Corinthians 5:17** NKJ "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he or she is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold all things have become new.

What is an overcomer? When the Apostle John wrote the book of **Revelation** he was writing to the seven churches in Asia Minor. In chapters 2 and 3 Jesus gave seven overcomer statements. In **Chapter 2:7**, "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes I will give to eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of Paradise of God." (NKJ) Notice Jesus says to he who that overcomes.

I would like to give you the Greek word for overcome is nik-ah-ah-o it means to subdue, conquer, **OVERCOME**, prevail, and get the victory.

We must also be faithful to go in the Rapture. I will list four scriptures for you to read regarding faithfulness:

- 1. Matthew 24:45
- 2. Matthew 25:21
- 3. 1st Corinthians 4:2
- 4. Revelation 17:4

I want to give you a quote from a great man of God who has gone to be with the Lord. W.H. Hubbard stated: "to escape great tribulation and be able to stand before the Son
