What Will God Remember About You In His Book Of Remembrance

I would like to pose a question to all who will read this newsletter, does God ever forget you? Obviously the answer is NO! Why? God is omniscient all knowing. He never forgets anything. A lot of Christians are not even aware of the Book of Remembrance mentioned only one time in the Bible. Where is it found? Answer—the Book of Malachi, the last book in the Old Testament. Malachi 3:16 "Then those who feared the Lord spoke to one another, and the Lord listened and heard them; So a Book of Remembrance was written before Him for those who fear the Lord and meditate on His name." Question—do you fear the Lord AND show Him all reverence and respect for who He is? Do you meditate on His name daily morning, noon and night? Most people don't even give God all the Glory when they hear what He has done! Case in point, I recently went to my barber to get a haircut, the shop was full of people as Terry's other barber was off on vacation. I said Terry can I brag on my God? Obviously he said yes and I began to tell him about what God did in a ladies unit in a Gatesville prison. You are not allowed to touch them or shake their hands. So while I was saying a corporate prayer, a blessing over the ladies before we left, in the middle of my prayer, the Lord gave me a Word of Knowledge (Ref. 1Corinthians 12:8) about a lady who could not hear. Immediately, I bound up the spirit of deafness and commanded it to loose her and that her ears be opened and then finished the blessing. As we were leaving a lady came up and said, "I received that healing, it was me, I can hear." I give God all the Glory for His mighty healing powers! NOT ONE PERSON IN THE BARBER SHOP SAID A WORD, CAN YOU **IMAGINE?** I thought to myself, well I guess the Lord's mighty miracle working power doesn't impress these folks, either they don't believe in healing or they have never seen healings in the church they attend. If the latter is the case, that is sad as we are in the last of the last days and God IS POURING OUT HIS SPIRIT! (Ref. Joel 2:28-30). Now if I would have talked about the election, or a rock star, or a famous Hollywood actor would I have gotten a reaction? The answer is **YES**. How <u>sad</u> it is that the <u>worldly</u> things are more important than the Miracle Working Powers of OUR GOD! I would like to give you an explanation of the Hebrew word pertaining to the book of Remembrance: Which is very important and will help you understand the importance of your name being written in it. Hebrew for Remembrance is Zikkaron meaning a recorded memento; a memorable day or writing. The Hebrew root is Zakar, meaning to mark, to mention, to be noteworthy. In other words it is a book that records something to mark a person noteworthy. Now let's talk about some people in the Bible remembered by name.

God remembered Noah (Ref. Genesis **6**) God marked him to do what he did. Noah was moved with FEAR and prepared an ark (Ref. Hebrews 11:7). Genesis 8:1 "And God remembered Noah, and every living thing, and all the cattle that was with him in the ark: and God made a wind to pass over the earth, and the waters subsided." God remembered Rachel and opened up her womb. Genesis 30:22 "Then God remembered Rachel, and God listened to her and opened her womb." The nation of Israel we know is very special to God Almighty as it states in Exodus 2:24 "So God heard their groaning, and God remembered His covenant Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob."

God remembered Hannah who was barren which was a disgrace not to be able to have children! (Ref. 1Samuel 1:19) "Then they rose early in the morning and worshiped before the LORD, and returned and came to their house at Ramah. And Elkanah knew Hannah his wife, and the LORD remembered her." God also remembers other things such as: 1. He remembers His covenant with His people (Ref. Exodus 6:5). 2. He remembers His children in time of need (Ref. Psalm 98:3). 3. He remembers and delivers in times of adversity (Ref. Numbers 10:9). I would say in the days of adversity we are living in, it is awesome to know He can and will deliver His righteous children.

So who does God Remember?

The Holy Spirit woke me early Saturday morning August 13, 2016 with a list of those He will Remember.

- Those who Love Him <u>Deuteronomy</u>
 11:13 love the Lord your God and serve Him with all your heart and with all your soul.
- Those who are Obedient
 <u>Deuteronomy 5:7</u> 'You shall have no other gods before Me.
- 3. Those who **Fear** God **Proverbs 15:33** The fear of the Lord is the instruction of wisdom, And before honor is humility.
- 4. Those who **Serve** God **Revelation**12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.
- 5. Those who are Faithful to God

 Matthew 25:23 His lord said to him,

 'Well done, good and faithful servant;

 you have been faithful over a few
 things, I will make you ruler over
 many things. Enter into the joy of
 your lord.'
- 6. Those who **Believe** God <u>Genesis 15:6</u>
 And he believed in the Lord, and He accounted it to him for righteousness.

7. Those who **Trust** God **Proverbs 3:5**Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding.

The question you must answer for yourself is WHAT WILL ALMIGHTY GOD, CREATOR OF ALL THINGS, REMEMBER ME FOR AND CONSIDER IT NOTEWORTHY?

God has given you time to prepare! God has sent you warnings and yet you are still not ready not for you or your household.

Our hearts are heavy for your children and grandchildren **because you refused to act** and have not prepared for them. You were given time by God's grace!

We are living in the days in which Jesus spoke of....as in the days of Noah and as in the days of Lot are upon us!

Have you explained to those of your family and friends that will be left here because they believe they have plenty of time and are still living in sin following after the desires of their own hearts. Have you explained about what happens if they accept the "mark of the beast" so they can buy food? Or that if they do accept the mark they are forever damned to eternal hell fire? Have you prepared them for the consequences of living in the tribulation because they are in rebellion of what God calls sin? They will be left here and either die by war, disease, famine, be martyred or if they take the "mark of the beast" they will be FOREVER LOST in the lake of fire.
