It is found in the book of Proverbs. “Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not to your own understanding.” Proverbs 3:5 This is a scripture we can all relate to. Remember how things went when you leaned on your own understanding?

The other goal of the ministry goes hand in hand with preaching the Gospel, and that is bringing this lost world to the knowledge of accepting Christ as their personal Savior. **John 3:16** *“For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.”* We know with God all things are possible. In the world today there are so many lost souls who are hurting. Some are bound by all types of addictions. In **John 8:36** *“So if the Son sets you free you are truly free”.* This is comforting to know that Jesus can and will heal all addictions, but YOU must ask and then BELIEVE to receive.

Warrior of God Ministries Personality Corner

This issue our personality is from the Old Testament. His name is Moses, who the Bible refers to as the most humble man. (Numbers 12:3) God, in the Bible is very specific about His plans for man. In Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the plans I have for you, “says the Lord.” They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope. (NLT) God has a plan a Divine Destiny for all of us. Moses’ Divine Destiny consisted of three parts:

1. Go tell Pharaoh to let **My** people go.
2. Lead them out of bondage through the wilderness.
3. Lead them into the promise land. God had promised them.

The question is, why didn’t Moses fulfill God’s plan for his life, and take the Israelites into the Promise Land? The answer is very simple and sad. Moses let anger lead him into disobedience. You may be asking yourself, anger, how did this stop Moses? The answer is simple. God gave Moses specific instructions on how to get water from a rock for the thirsty complaining Israelites. If Moses would have followed God’s

instructions, God would have received all the glory for the miracle instead of Moses. Let’s go to God’s Word and read the incident that prevented Moses from entering the promise land. The incident is found in the book of Numbers 20:6-12. Before we read about Moses disobedience, let’s look back at all the times God used Moses as His vessel to show the Israelites His miracles; Moses demonstrated 40 miracles by God’s power prior to the miracle of water coming from the rock at Kadesh.

Now we all know how the Israelites were always whining, complaining, and would test anyone’s patience. The problem the Israelites had was that Moses took them out of Egypt but you couldn’t get Egypt out of the Israelites.

Numbers 20:6 So Moses and Aaron went from the presence of the assembly to the door of the tabernacle of meeting and they fell on their faces. And the glory of the Lord appeared to them. (v) 7 Then the Lord spoke to Moses saying, (v) 8 Take the rod; you and your brother Aaron gather the congregation together **Speak to the rock before their eyes**, and it will yield it’s water for them out of the rock, and give drink to

them and their animals. (v) 10 And Moses and Aaron gathered the assembly together before the rock; and he (Moses) said to them, “Hear now, you rebels! Must **we** bring water for you out of this rock”? (v) 11 Then Moses lifted his hand and **struck the rock twice** with his rod; and water came out abundantly, and the congregation and their animals drank.

Now the moment Moses **struck** the rock instead of **SPEAKING** to it, as God commanded he fell into disobedience.

Now let’s look at (v) 12 Then the Lord spoke to Moses and Aaron, “Because you did not believe Me, to hallow Me in the eyes of the children of Israel, therefore you shall **NOT** bring this assembly into the land which I have given them.”

Moses paid a severe penalty for his anger, it cost him his Devine Destiny. Leading the children of Israel into the promise land God, had promised them.

We all must ask ourselves this question. What is in our way of God’s plan for our lives? Is it anger, doubt, frustration of trying to do things our way, laziness, or not hearing God’s voice when He speaks to us?

Discern the times.

Of the children of Issachar who had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do, 1 Chronicles 12:32a Jesus said, "If you had known, even you, especially in this your day, the things that make for your peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes. For the days will come upon you when your enemies will build an embankment around you, surround you and close you in on every side, and level you, and your children within you, to the ground; and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, because you did not know the time of your visitation."

Luke 19:42-44

This was fulfilled in 70 A.D.

How many years have you heard, "**Repent the Lord is coming!**" Are you excited? Telling everyone that Jesus is coming! Or are you saying, "I have heard that all my life," "ever since I was saved." Have you become blasé, lackadaisical, or maybe you just say, "I know but that's a long way off, even in the Bible they thought He was coming back any day and that was almost 2000 years ago." Do you know what Jesus called that kind of attitude? Lukewarm...remember what Jesus said would happen if when He returns and finds you "lukewarm?"

The church of Laodiceans in Revelation 3:15-16

"I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot. I wish that you were cold or hot. So then, because you are lukewarm and neither cold nor hot, I will spew you out of My mouth."

Wow, Jesus said he knew you were doing a lot of works but that didn't seem to be the heart condition He wants. Well, what does that mean?

There are no signs left that must occur before the "gathering of the saints" (aka the Rapture) referred to in 1 Thessalonians 4:13-17, 16) For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. 17) Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.

You say well, this will not happen until the falling away and the man of sin is revealed "the antichrist" 2 Thes 2:3-4, but this refers to the second coming of Christ which is at the end of the tribulation. The second coming of Christ will be at the end of the Tribulation seven (7) years after the gathering together of the Overcomers.

John the apostle said, in Rev 4:1-2, After these things I looked, and behold a door standing open in heaven. And the first voice which I heard was like a trumpet speaking with me, saying "Come up here and I will show you things which must take place after this." Immediately I was in the Spirit; and behold a throne set in heaven, and One sat on the throne.

Right after Jesus tells us about all the different churches and their conditions then John is taken up to heaven. Which is a picture of the gathering together of the saints (Rapture) and they are taken to heaven.

What is your heart condition? Is the Spirit of God tugging at your heart? Do you hear Him whisper, "Draw closer to me, I miss you, I love you! Yes, I know you are working for me and I want you to, but I want us to be close again."

Jesus said, "As many as I love, I rebuke and chastise. Therefore be zealous and Repent."
